





The Colene Hoose Elementary School Natural Playground Project 25-09-2020

Founder of The Jobson Family Foundation, Mr. Charles Jobson's vision:

The Colene Hoose Elementary School natural playground project should be a model for other schools in the area and become a community gathering spot.

Located in Bloomington Normal, Illinois, the public school has around 450 students, of which 15 % are students with special needs of varying kinds. The school was built in the mid-1960s and has changed little since that time. The land surrounding the school is pancake flat and compressed with little vegetation except grass and there are cracked concrete basketball courts, some swings, and a plug and play playground equipment set.

Landscape Architect Helle Nebelong's mission:

Transforming the Colene Hoose School flat environment into a natural playscape that could be a model for other schools in the area and become a community gathering spot.

The playground project should be comprehensive, challenging, stimulating and inclusive.




Others may want to explore how specific 'rooms' and design features work. The current design caters for both these perspectives, and more.

McLean County Unit 5 administrators and project developers joined Jobson on Tuesday to show their progress on the highly anticipated playground that has been in the works for almost three years.

Designed by Danish landscape architect Helle Nebelong, the playground occupies the 16-acre plot adjacent from the school along Vernon Avenue and implements natural materials throughout the various spaces.
